Call for Scholarships for students enrolled in the International Master's Degree Course in Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control of the Department of Veterinary Medicine - University of Sassari

DEADLINE: 30/10/2024

Considering the Decree Rep. Nr. 4193/2022, Prot. Nr. 0125908 of 14/11/2022 whereby the University of Sassari, with a deliberation passed by the Academic Senate on 26 July 2022 and by the Board of Directors on 3 August 2022, approved the use of profits allocated to reserves for the funding of teaching projects, of which €20.000 for each of the 7 international degree courses activated at the University of Sassari for a total of €140.000,00 to be used for scholarships;

Considering the Decree by which the University of Sassari has determined to charge the sum of €20,000, inclusive of any charges to be borne by the Administration, to the project "BORSELAUREEINTERNAZIONALI2021" for the allocation of scholarships for students of the international CdLM in "Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control";

Recognising that the above amount will be authorised for the international CdLM in Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control;

Acquired the resolution of the Council of the Department of Veterinary Medicine of 9 October 2024 establishing the requirements and procedures for the allocation of scholarships for students enrolled in the CdLM in Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control;

The Department of Veterinary Medicine is establishing 19 scholarships, amounting to a maximum of € 600,00 each, based on the requirements set, for students enrolled in the international CdLM in Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control in the academic year 2023/2024.

Art. 1 - Admission requirements

To participate in the selection, under penalty of exclusion, candidates must meet the following requirements:

- being enrolled in the second year of the international CdLM in Wildlife Management, conservation and Control in the academic year 2024/2025;
- having achieved at least 30 CFUs on the date of publication of the call;

- having participated in at least half of the excursions scheduled by the CdLM in Wildlife Management Conservation and Control in the academic year 2023/2024.

Art. 2 - Incompatibility

The scholarship cannot be combined with scholarships/awards granted for the same purpose by the University of Sassari.

The scholarship is compatible with other forms of study aid provided by the Ente Regionale per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario (ERSU)

Art. 3 - Award Criteria and Commission Appointment

The scholarship is awarded upon verification of fulfilment of the requirements carried out by a Commission specifically appointed by the Director of the Department and composed of: President of the Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control study course; Vice - President of the Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control study course; and Teaching Manager of the Department of Veterinary Medicine.

Art. 4 - Submission of applications: terms and procedures

The application for participation and its annexes must be submitted by **12 PM** (noon) on **30 October 2024**, by filling in the form attached to this notice (Annex 1) and sending it by PEC to dip.medicina.veterinaria@pec.uniss.it

As subject of the PEC the following text must be written: "Public notice for scholarship assignments to the Master's Degree Course in Wildlife Management, Conservation and Control". Application form and attachments are admissible if signed with a digital or a handwritten signature (in the latter case, a scanned version of the application must be sent) and must be accompanied by a valid identification document in PDF format.

The application is only valid if the candidate complies with the above procedure. Sending the application on paper format is not admitted.

Candidates must, under penalty of nullity, enclose with their application:

- 1) copy of valid passport. EU citizens are allowed to attach copy of a valid identity card;
- 2) certification of examinations taken, complete with CFUs and grade obtained, in Italian or English language

All documents submitted by the candidate must be in Italian or English.

Incomplete applications without all the required documents will not be considered

Art. 5 - Formation and approval of the ranking list of candidates, and evaluation criteria in case of parity

The ranking list of candidates is drawn up by the appointed Commission and approved by decree of the Director of the Department of Veterinary Medicine.

Eligible candidates will be awarded the scholarships in question.

The ranking list will be published on the Department of Veterinary Medicine website at <https://veterinaria.uniss.it/it>.

Successful applicants will in any case be notified of the publication of the ranking list by email.

Art. 6 – Acceptance

Successful applicants will be notified of the award of the scholarship by e-mail together with a declaration of acceptance. With such declaration, the successful candidate must give explicit assurance, under his/her own responsibility, that he/she does not incur in the incompatibilities envisaged by art. 2 of this call.

The candidate must send the declaration of acceptance of the scholarship by e-mail to wmcc@uniss.it within 3 (three) working days from notification, under penalty of loss of the scholarship.

Art. 7 – Payment terms and scholarship maintenance requirements

Scholarships in the net amount of € 600,00 will be awarded to students who have participated in all the excursions scheduled by the course of Wildlife Management Conservation and Control in the academic year 2023/2024. Half of this amount (€ 300,00) will be awarded to students who have participated in at least half the excursions scheduled by the course of Wildlife Management Conservation and Control in the academic year 2023/2024

The scholarship will be paid out in a single instalment.

The awarding of scholarships is conditional on the achievement of credits and participation in excursions planned by the course of study. Credits, achieved at the date of publication of the call for applications, must have been obtained and recorded at the University of Sassari (Art. 34 of the University Teaching Regulations) or at other universities.

Payment of the scholarships will be made by bank transfer to a current account or prepaid card with Italian IBAN owned or co-owned by the beneficiary student.
